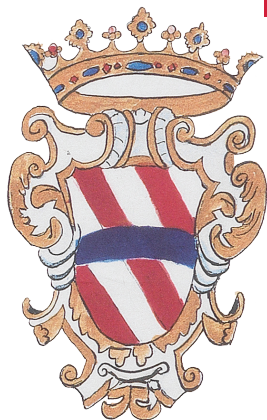


MAKE YOUR MARK!

Draw a personalised family crest

A family crest is a stamp of identity that tells the world who you are and connects you with your family history.

It is like an illustrated map or clue to where you come from, who you are connected to, and what you might aspire to in the future.

It is often handed down from generation to generation, like the Corsini family crest.

Take a minute to think about your family's values, ancestry and hopes. In what ways are love, power, strength and connection important to you?

Talk to a grown up about what **lineage** means.

- An animal representing your extended family
- A flag showing the countries you originated from (or invent one!)
- Symbols for things your immediate family loves
- Pictures of foods your grandparents make
- An ornate design of the first letter of your surname
- Tiny drawings showing activities you love to share
