Overview

This visit to the Art Gallery will enhance the students' understanding of art and stimulate their imaginations. Students will be introduced to artworks in a wide variety of styles and materials to enhance their art knowledge and to encourage discussion.

Guided Tour

Students will:

- Explore themes such as myths, animals and open spaces.
- Imagine what different people are like based on their portraits.
- Wonder what far away places might be like to visit; the conditions, colours and sounds.
- Immerse themselves in a narrative, imagining how they might act, feel or sound.

Before your visit

Discuss why the students will be visiting the Art Gallery. **Collect** reproductions of artworks and arrange them thematically to explore different ways artists create art. **Select** an Australian artist and examine how he/she has used a myth, Dreaming story or fable to create a colourful new image. **Choose** an artwork for close investigation and identify the formal elements such as line, shape, tone, form, colour, texture, pattern.
