EARLY ADOLESCENCE PROGRAM

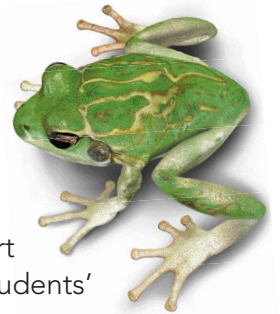
Overview
