- Enthusiasm for Perth arts and culture, and willingness to learn.
- Exceptional communication skills.
- High proficiency in the English language.
- Proficiency in a second language, such as AUSLAN, is valuable but not required.
- A reliable and positive attitude towards work.
- The ability to work as part of a team.

AS A KNOWLEDGE GATHERER, YOU WILL:

- Approach Gallery visitors with audience surveys.
- Answer any queries visitors may have about surveys.
- Where necessary, assist visitors with the completion of audience surveys.
- Achieve a target number of surveys completed each shift.

VOLUNTEERING REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to commit to a minimum of one morning or afternoon shift per fortnight.
- Volunteers must wear their provided AGWA uniform and maintain a suitable standard of presentation.
- All volunteers require a current Police Clearance. AGWA will assist with submitting these clearances for any volunteer who does not have one.
