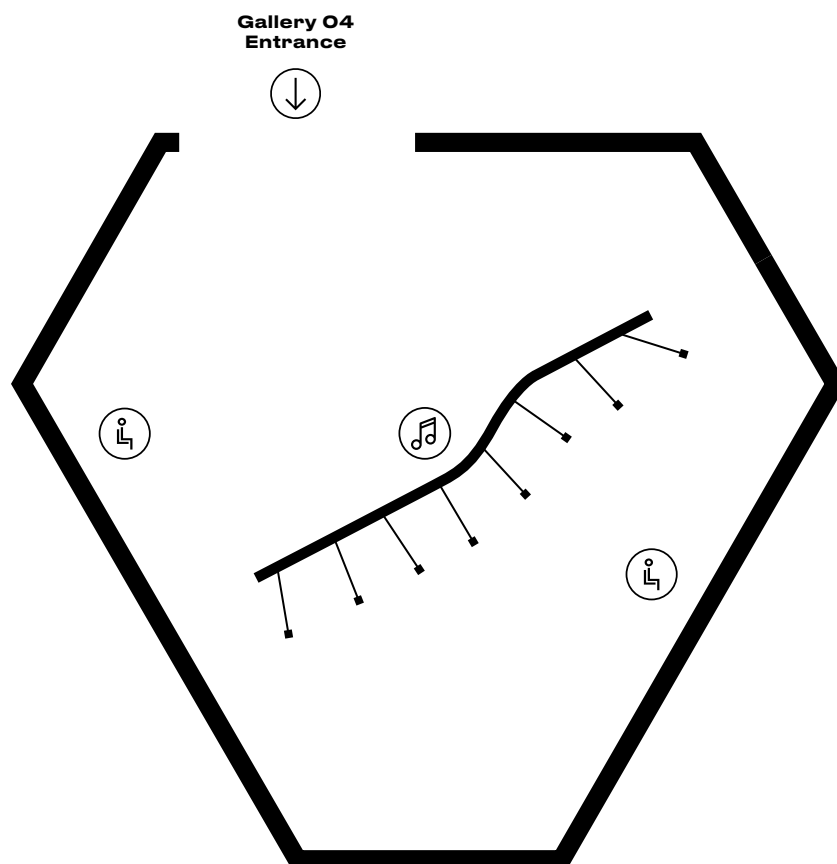
Welcome to The Art Gallery of Western Australia. This Sensory and Access Map is designed to show where sensory elements, audio-visual content and seating is within this exhibition.

GALLERY 04 | GROUND FLOOR

This exhibition has bright orange walls and a large multi-coloured artwork made from textile hanging from the ceiling, which spans most of the width of the exhibition space. At the back of the artwork there are several tension cords and blocks, which may present a trip hazard. For the safety of visitors and the artwork a verbal proximity notice may be activated when visitors come within close range of the artwork.



A universal access toilet (RH) is located on Ground Floor, and a universal access toilet (LH) on Rooftop level. Ambulant toilets are located on Rooftop level, and a Parent's / Carer's room on Ground Floor.
