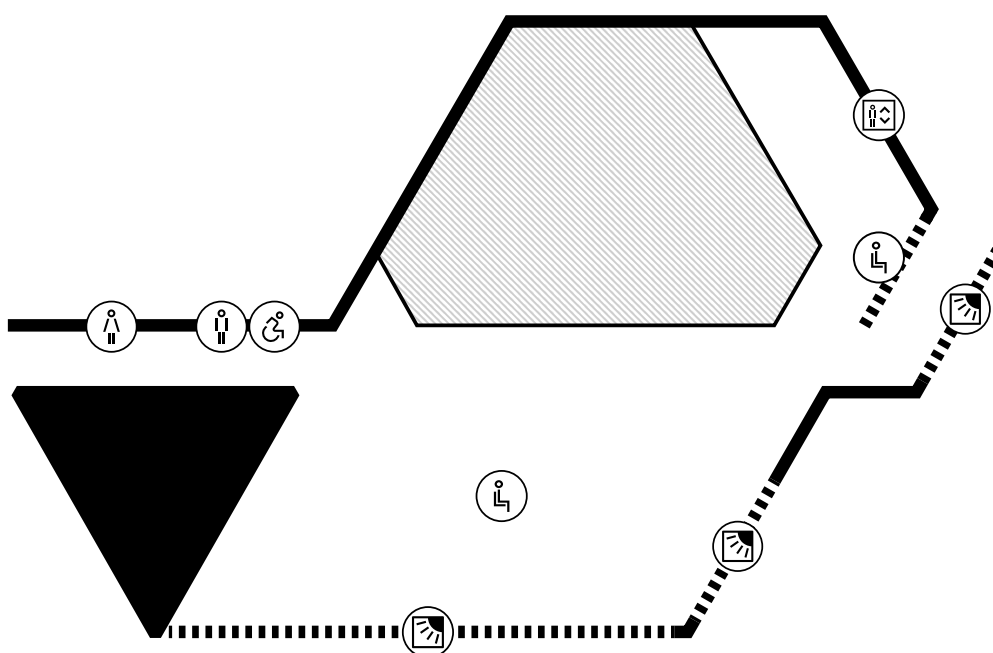
Welcome to The Art Gallery of Western Australia. This Sensory and Access Map is designed to show where sensory elements, audio-visual content and seating is within this exhibition.

# Sensory and Access Map: *Cast in bronze*

GALLERY 10, ROOFTOP LEVEL

This exhibition is a low-sensory environment with natural light from the large windows around the perimeter with views to the city skyline. There are several plinths located in the middle of the exhibition space and on the walls displaying mainly bronze sculptures of various sizes.



A universal access toilet (RH) is located on Ground Floor, and a universal access toilet (LH) on Rooftop level. Ambulant toilets are located on Rooftop level, and a Parent's / Carer's room on Ground Floor.
