HANDS-ON WORKSHOPS

Bookings are essential

Experimental and process-based workshops facilitated by AGWA's Teaching Artists are delivered within Gallery spaces. These hands-on workshops explore ideas, visual language, material practice and composition through ongoing reflection, testing and critical thinking strategies.

Cost: \$10 per student. Adult supervisors are free.

Duration: 45min to 1 hour.

School and community groups are only able to engage in Gallery 09 exhibitions with a confirmed workshop booking.



INTERACTIVE TOURS

Bookings are essential

Volunteer Gallery Guides provide interactive, age-appropriate tours that engage students in lively and responsive conversations about art practice, concepts and techniques. These tours typically focus on Gallery Highlights and can be tailored to suit your group's needs.

Cost: Free

Duration: Early Learning – Year 2 (30 min).
Year 3 (45 min) | Year 4 and above (1 hour).

Session duration can be adjusted to accommodate your availability.

VISUAL ANALYSIS

Bookings are essential

With a focus on visual literacy and interpretation strategies, Teaching Artists apply slow looking approaches to visual analysis, supporting students to meaningfully engage with works of art. Drawing from visual literacies and analysis frameworks, these experiences allow students to share personal perspectives and articulate a deeper understanding of elements and principles.

Cost: \$15 per student. Adult supervisors are free.

Duration: 1 hour.

Visual Analysis is recommended for students in Year 9, 10, 11 and 12.

SELF-GUIDED VISITS

Bookings are essential

If you plan to self-guide your group independently, it is essential you inform us so we can be prepared for your visit. We request that students are guided through the Gallery in smaller groups with at least one adult supervisor accompanying each group, generally 10 students per 1 supervisor ratio.

Cost: Free

School and community groups are only able to engage in Gallery 09 exhibitions with a confirmed workshop booking.



SELF-GUIDED DRAWING

Bookings are essential

Explore artworks through mark making and drawing practices. Book a drawing pack to self-guide your group. You will be provided with graphite pencils, blending stumps, viewfinders, cartridge paper and clipboards with drawing prompts to help guide you.

Cost: Free

Drawing packs must be returned to Front Desk at conclusion of your visit.
